

- **Sec. 42-90. - Truck and bus traffic restricted on certain city streets.**

(a)

Streets enumerated. Single-unit trucks with six or more tires, all combination unit trucks and commercial buses shall be prohibited from traveling in the city limits on the following streets:

(1)

West Liberty Street and East Liberty Street (S.C. Highway No. 5 and S.C. Highway No. 161) between the intersection of West Liberty Street and U.S. Highway No. 321 Bypass on the west side of the city and the city limits on East Liberty Street on the east side of the city.

(2)

South Congress Street, North Congress Street and Kings Mountain Street (U.S. Highway No. 321 Business) between the intersection of South Congress Street and U.S. Highway No. 321 on the south side of the city and the intersection of Kings Mountain Street and U.S. Highway No. 321 on the northwest side of the city.

(3)

Sharon Road (S.C. Highway No. 49) between the intersection of Sharon Road and U.S. Highway No. 321 Bypass on the southwest side of the city and the intersection of Sharon Road and South Congress Street (U.S. Highway No. 321 Business) at Pinckney Street.

(4)

North Congress Street (S.C. Highway No. 49) between the intersection of North Congress Street and Kings Mountain Street and the city limits on North Congress Street (S.C. Highway No. 49) on the northeastern side of the city.

(5)

Church Street for the entire length of said street, from the point that intersects with East Liberty Street to the point that intersects with East Jefferson Street.

(6)

Springdale Drive for the entire length of said street, from the point that it intersects with East Liberty Street to the point that it intersects East Jefferson Street.

(b)

Exceptions. The limitations provided for in this section shall not apply to:

(1)

Trucks engaged in the delivery of products and merchandise to establishments located within the city limits nor to trucks engaged in public service along such streets;

(2)

Buses engaged in the transportation of school children and buses engaged in the transportation of persons to Sunday school and church and buses engaged in the transportation of passengers within the city limits; and

(3)

Trucks, buses/drivers going to and from home when their residence is on a street which intersects one of the prohibited streets;

Provided, however, that a permit granting permission for such travel must be obtained from the chief of police and such permit shall be valid only when in the possession of the applicant to whom it is issued. (Code 1977, § 15-60; Ord. No. 13-543, 6-4-2013; Ord. No. [21-650](#), 5-4-2021)


AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CITY OF YORK CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO TRUCK AND BUS TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS ON CERTAIN STREETS

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of York, South Carolina in Council assembled, that Chapter 42, *Traffic and Vehicles*, Article III, *Operation*, Section 42-90 *Truck and Bus Traffic Restricted on Certain City Streets* be amended as follows:

(b) *Exceptions*. The limitations provided for in this section shall not apply to:


(1) Trucks engaged in the delivery of products and merchandise to establishments ~~located within the city limits~~ located along the roadways listed in (a) nor to trucks engaged in public service along such streets;
