- Mail original of page one (1) Trespass Notice to person you wish to place on "notice of no trespassing." Page one (1) must be mailed: Restricted, Certified Mail, with return receipt requested. Keep a copy of the original for your records and later use.
- 2. After the U. S. Postal Service returns the signed receipt to you, mail or deliver a copy of the receipt and a copy of the Trespass Notice to:

- 3. Include a daytime telephone number where an Officer can call you if needed.
- 4. Include all addresses of property in which you wish to have the person trespassed from.
- 5. Keep the original receipt and a copy of the Trespass Notice for yourself.
- 6. Trespass Notices are kept on file by the York Police Department until they are rescinded (removed) by you and/or you sell or vacate the property. If you wish to rescind the Trespass Notice, you must personally deliver a Notarized Letter to the York Police Department detailing that the notice is to be removed.
