

Trash (Non-Household Garbage)

Trash includes large items such as:

1. Furniture (i.e. sofas, chairs, etc.) | Any glass in the item must be removed and disposed of separately.
2. Appliances
3. Rugs
4. Mattresses

Trash also includes:

1. Cardboard Boxes | Only if broken down and placed in trash bags.
2. Leaves
3. Limbs
4. Yard Debris | [Yard Debris/Limb](#) for a list of acceptable items , These items must be set separately from Trash Items

Trash Does Not Include:

1. Electronics
2. Televisions
3. Glass (or anything with glass in it)

Any items not accepted by the City of York may be disposed of at your local [York County Convenience Center](#)

Items such as furniture are collected once per week on the same day as your garbage collection and may be placed on the curbside for pick up.

- Appliances and metal should be kept separate from trash so they can be picked up separately.
- No construction/destruction debris will be collected by the city. (Code 1977 10-21.2) [Sec. 36-46](#), (Code 1977 10-21.3) [Sec. 36-47](#).
